Sir,

This has reference to your letter No.MCL/SBP/GM(ENVT)/2017/8519 dated 7<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 along with online proposal No. IA/OR/CMIN/70681/2014 and subsequent letters dated 14.11.2017, 19.11.2017, 22.11.2017, 23.11.2017, 27.11.2017 and 28.11.2017, on the above-mentioned subject.

- 2. The proposal is for amendment in environmental clearance dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 for Ananta OCP Expansion Project, Phase-III from 15 to 20 MTPA of M/s Mahanadi Coalfields Limited in an area of 1181.968 ha in Tehsil Talcher, District Angul (Odisha).
- 3. The proposal was considered by the Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) in the Ministry for Thermal & Coal Mining sector in its 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2017. The details of the project, as per the documents submitted by the project proponent, and also as informed during the meeting, are reported to be as under:-
- (i) Ananta OCP expansion project, Phase-III was granted environmental clearance by the Ministry vide letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014, for expansion from 15 MTPA to 20 MTPA of M/s Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd in mine lease area of 1181.968 ha in Tehsil Talcher, District Angul (Odisha). The said EC was granted after taking out/excluding the forest land of 237.853 ha from the total area of 1419.821 ha due to Stage-I forest clearance not available for the said forest land at that point of time.
- (ii) The present proposal is for amendment in the EC dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014, mainly in respect of adding the forest land to the area for which the EC was issued, modifying the condition for expenditure towards CSR and some typographical errors, with the details as under:-

- (iii) Now, Stage-I forest clearance has been granted for the forest land vide letter No. 8-37/2015-FC dated 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2017. Therefore, EC may be granted for the entire ML area of 1419.821 ha including forest land.
- 4. The EAC, after deliberations, has recommended for adding the forest land of 237.853 ha to the present project area of 1181.968 ha, making the total area available now as 1419.821 ha.
- 5. Based on recommendations of the EAC, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby accords approval to the proposed amendments in the environmental clearance dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 to the above said project, mainly for adding the forest land of 237.853 ha to the present project area of 1181.968 ha, making the total area available for the project now as 1419.821 ha.

Further, as recommended by the EAC, the Ministry also accords approval to the amendments/corrections in the said EC, as requested by the project proponent and explained in the table at para 3(ii) above.

6. All other terms and conditions stipulated in the Environmental Clearance dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2014 shall remain unchanged.
