Sub: Diversion of 289.856 ha. of forest land for coal mining in Naturaj Underground Mines in favour of M/s Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd., in Angul district of Orissa.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No. 10F(Cons.)88/2004/11306/F&E dated: 29-7-2004 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Govt. under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, and to say that the proposal has been examined by the Forest Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under Section 3 of the aforesaid Act.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, and on the basis of recommendations of the above-mentioned Advisory Committee, the Central Government, hereby, agrees in-principle for diversion of 289.856 ha, of forest land for coal mining in Nataraj Underground Mines in favour of M/s Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd., in Angul district of Orissa, subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

The user agency will transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation on double the degraded forest land in lieu of 8.043 ha of forest land to be diverted for surface rights, to the State Forest Department.

User Agency shall deposit the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land of 289.856 ha, with the State Forest Department as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 30-10-2002 & 1-8-2003 in I.A No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide letter No.5-1/98-FC(Pt-II) deted 18-9-2003 and 22-9-2003 in this regard.

The State Government shall deposit the above-mentioned funds in form of Fixed Deposits in the name of concerned DFO/ Nodal Officer of the State, till such time the Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) intimates the Head of Accounts for deposition of funds.

4. The user agency will demarcate and protect the diverted forest land by erecting a stonewall / trench / barbed wire fencing with iron angle (in consultation with the State Forest Department) and will maintain the fencing

during entire period of life of mine. Gap planting, wherever required, may be curried out in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.

5. Prior to Stage-II Clearance, user agency shall submit No Objection Certificate' from local Gram Sabha for utilizing the area under surface rights which is currently under use as Gochar land.

6. Strict monitoring of subsidence shall be done by the State Mining Department and the State Forest Department at regular intervals and all measures recommended by CMRI shall be undertaken by the user agency to avoid subsidence.

 Other standard conditions as applicable in case of underground mining projects, shall apply in the instant case also.

After receipt of compliance report on the fulfilment of the conditions no.1,2,3,4 and 5 from the State Government, formal approval will be issued in this regard under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Transfer of forest land to user agency shall not be effected by the State Government till the final orders for diversion of forest land are issued by the Central Government.
