**Cairns Cup:** In St Louis, USA, Koneru Humpy and Dronavalli Harika settled for contrasting draws in the fourth round of the Cairns Cup chess tournament. Humpy was held by Kateryna Lagno of Russia while Harika could not force a win against American Irina Krush.

**Rising star:** India forward Lalremliam has been named the 2019 Women's Rising Star of the Year, the international hockey federation said on Tuesday. The 19-year-old took the prize ahead of Argentina's Julieta Jankunas and Frederique Matia of the Netherlands.

**Marathon masks:** Organisers of the Tokyo Marathon will distribute surgical masks to runners and volunteers if they request them over concerns about coronavirus. Additional "preventive safety measures against the virus" will be taken at the event set for 1 March.

**Farah cleared:** The International Tennis Federation has lifted the provisional suspension it imposed on reigning Wimbledon and the US Open men's doubles champion Robert Farah following his positive test for the banned substance Boldenone. He is cleared to return.

**McNamara collapses:** Former Celtic defender Jackie McNamara is in hospital after collapsing near his home. McNamara, 46, is understood to have been admitted to the hospital for brain surgery. He was stated to have collapsed on Saturday.

'Pele depressed'



RIO DE JANEIRO, 11 FEBRUARY:

Football legend Pele (*in photo*) is experiencing "a kind of depression" and barely leaves home anymore because health problems have left him unable to walk normally, his son said in an interview.

"He's pretty fragile in terms of his mobility... and that makes him suffer a kind of depression," Edinho said of his 79-year-old father, who has had a series of health problems in recent years. "Just imagine, he's the 'King', he was always such an imposing figure, and now he can't walk normally. He gets very shy, very embarrassed about that," his son said in an interview published on the sports news site *Globoesporte.com* yesterday. Pele, the pride of Brazilian football and the only player to win three World Cups (1958, 1962 and 1970), is considered by many to be the greatest footballer of all time.

He has been in and out of hospital in recent years for various health issues.

He never fully recovered from one of his hip operations, leaving him dependent on a walker, Edinho said.

"He's doing a bit better than when he was in a wheelchair recently, but he still has a hard time getting around," said Edinho, 49.

Pele's public appearances have grown increasingly rare with age.

Last April he traveled to Paris for a promotional appearance with French rising star Kylian Mbappe, but had to be hospitalised shortly after for kidney problems.

In 2014, he was placed in intensive care for dialysis after contracting a severe urinary infection.

The Brazilian great, whose real name is Edson Arantes do Nascimento, has only one kidney, after a broken rib during a match forced doctors to remove the other. He has also suffered a series of hip problems.

Edinho said despite those issues his father is "doing well" physically. **AFF**

'India playing kabaddi politics'

'Statements by New Delhi officials were the result of rifts between national-level factions'

The Pakistan Kabaddi Federation yesterday rejected Indian authorities' claims that they had not "approved" any team to participate in the ongoing Kabaddi World Cup 2020. Earlier yesterday, the Indian authorities said they had not approved any team from the country to participate in the kabaddi World Cup currently underway in Pakistan, a day after the athletes had arrived via the Wagah border. The statement caused uncertainty over the status of the athletes representing India in the world event.

Addressing the media in Lahore, PKF president Chaudhry Shafay Hussain held "enemy elements" responsible for the confusion and said: "The fact is that the Kabaddi World Cup is being held in Pakistan for the first time. It was held only in India previously. Some enemy



elements are conspiring (against the event)."

The PKF president also said that a first information report would be lodged against those spreading "false propaganda". PKF secretary Rana Sarwar said that the visiting team happened to be India's national team and cautioned against mixing sport with politics. Sarwar urged critics to "check the rankings of all the players" in the Indian team. He said that the statements by

Indian officials were the result of rifts between national-level factions.

*DawnNewsTV* approached Indian players and the team management too, but they did not comment on the situation. All of the previous six-circle-style kabaddi World Cups have been hosted by India, the most recent event having taken place in 2016.

Pakistan is hosting the event for the first time this year. The tournament will be eight-day-long with matches in Lahore, Faisalabad, Kartarpur and Nankana Sahib. Other than India, teams from Iran, Canada, Australia, the United States, Sierra Leone and Kenya are also participating in the event.

Amid the ongoing confusion, the Indian side defeated Germany yesterday.

'No idea' who went  
Indian Olympic Association chief Narinder Batra said yesterday he had "no idea" about the players who had gone to

Pakistan as neither the Indian Olympic Association nor the Amateur Kabaddi Federation of India (AKFI) had approved any team to participate in the World Cup.

"The IOA has not approved and it has also not been approved by the federation so I don't know who has gone. Whether 60 or 100 have gone,

I have no idea. The kabaddi federation, which is a member of the IOA, has confirmed that they have not sent anyone. I have seen statements from the (sport) ministry which confirm they have not approved anyone. So I don't know who they are and what the story is," he was quoted as saying.

Indian Arrows, Neroca play out goal-less draw

Srikanth leads India's rout of Kazakhstan

Kidambi Srikanth (*in photo*) spearheaded India's 4-1 mauling of Kazakhstan in their opening group match to brighten their chances of reaching the quarter-finals of the Asia Team Badminton Championships here today.

Former world number one Srikanth, the up and coming Lakshya Sen and Subhankar Dey won their singles matches easily.

Srikanth took just 23 minutes to beat Dmitry Panarin 21-10, 21-7 while Sen was even quicker, notching up a 21-13, 21-8 win over Artur Niyazov in 21 minutes. Dey beat Khaitmurat Kulmatov 21-11, 21-5 in 26 minutes in the third singles.

World Championship bronze medalist B Sai Praneeth, who was not fielded in the singles today, teamed up with Chirag Shetty in the doubles, but lost to the Kazakh pair of Niyazov and Panarin 21-18 16-21 19-21.

However, M R Arjun and Dhruv Kapila beat the Kazakh duo of Nikita Bragin and Khaitmurat Kulmatov 21-14 21-8 in the second doubles match.

The Indian men's team, which won a bronze in the 2016 championship, was initially clubbed with two-time defending champions Indonesia and hosts Philippines in Group A, but with China and Hong Kong not playing due to a travel ban on them by the Philippines because of the coronavirus outbreak, the draw was re-worked.

The Indian team have been placed in Group B alongside Malaysia and Kazakhstan.

It's Ronaldo v Ibrahimovic

MILAN, 11 FEBRUARY:

Cristiano Ronaldo and Zlatan Ibrahimovic are set to go head-to-head in Thursday's Italian Cup semi-final, first leg between Juventus and AC Milan at the San Siro.

Both Ronaldo and Ibrahimovic scored at the weekend in defeats as Juventus fell 2-1 at Hellas Verona, while AC Milan threw away a two-goal lead in a 4-2 defeat by city rivals Inter.

"It wasn't the result we wanted," said the 35-year-old Ronaldo despite becoming the first Juventus player to score in 10 successive league games, just one game short of the Serie A record.

The five-time Ballon d'Or winner has scored 23 goals in all competitions this season.

Ibrahimovic, 38, has scored three goals since returning to Milan last month. The Swede headed in the second goal on Sunday after setting up the first, but Inter hit back with four second-half strikes.

"I showed that I can still make a difference, even at 38," he said. But Inter striker Romelu Lukaku will be looking to upstage the two other former Manchester United players against Napoli in the other last-four first leg on Wednesday.

Gennaro Gattuso's Napoli, despite their current slump, ousted holders Lazio in the quarter-finals. "There's a new king in town," a jubilant Lukaku wrote on Twitter after scoring the fourth goal for Inter in Sunday's derby.

"We run this town." The Belgian was replying to Ibrahimovic's pre-derby post saying that "lions don't compare themselves to humans". Juventus coach Maurizio Sarri has reason to be worried by his side's away form, with the defending Serie A champions having lost their last two games on the road. "I hope that someone will help me, it's something we have to resolve," Sarri said after the loss to Verona. "Right now we have a difference in performance between home and away." **AFF**
