As the number of vehicles running on kerosene keeps increasing, they not only usurp the poor people's quota, but also damage the environment and public health. Hundreds of trucks and buses operating in the district have blatantly flouted the norms, it is alleged. District administration has done precious little to check use of kerosene in transport buses, it is alleged. Kerosene is an essential commodity for the poor. Its value is more in pockets where electricity is still a dream.



Pointing out that some bus owners buy kerosene from dealers as it is cheaper than diesel and use it in their vehicles. Private Bus Owners' Association Secretary Durga Prasad Tripathy had written a letter to all the Collectors of undivided Koraput district.

Bandh paralyses MCL's mining ops

Sambalpur, Jan 8: The efforts of Mahanadi Coalfields Limited (MCL) to recover its production loss of 4,867 million tonne in the current fiscal due to disturbances was fur-ther hit by Tuesday's country-wide bandh as coal mining and supply operations were naralysed

ther hit by Tuesday's county where ware as coal mining and supply operations were paralysed.

The MCLs awerage coal production stood at 4.65 lakh tonne a day. It could plunge further from its negative growth rate of 0.87 per cent to around 1.31 per cent in the current fiscal had it not been for the loss of working hours during the bandh.

The MCL had produced 101.875 million tonne ill January 7, 2019 against the 102.456

MT produced during the corresponding period in the previous fiscal. Even loaded rail rakes were stopped from moving out 13 million tonne in coal production loss of around 1.35 million tonne in coal production loss due to work stoppage on 37 working days during the current fiscal, amounting to a loss of around 1.03 million tonne in coal production. At the end of the third quarter December 32 per cent of the total production of Coal India. As per records, 10 million tonne an mula capacity of Kaniha project in Talcher Coalfields was the most affected mine with

The MCL had produced 101,575 million tonne till Jan 7, 2019 against 102.465 MT produced during the corresponding period in the previous fiscal.

nine working days were lost at the 16 MT Bharatpur OCP, around eight working days at the 16 MT Lingara; OCP and around six working days at six MT Jagannath OCP. Ananta OCP of six MT annual capacity was the only mine in Talcher Coalfields which did not suffer any disturbance during the first three quarters of financial year 2019, and continues to exceed target. Similarly, mines in IB Valley Coalfields also suffered loss of working hours, although not as much as Talcher Coalfields. The major setback at the IB Valley Coalfields was at the 21 MT capacity Lakhanpur OCP, which suffered stoppage for a week up to the third quarter, resulting in a loss of production of 0.4 million tonne.

Similarly, the 13.7 MT Kulda OCP lost five days of work, and the adjacent two MT Basundhara (West) suffered a loss of 14 days of work.

With a target of 162.5 MT for the current fiscal, the company had planned a record production of 100 MT from Talcher Coalfields alone, and the rest from the mines in IB Valley Coalfields.
