2.4 Certificates.

All cases of warranty replacement of failed item will be decided on the basis of joint inspection of the failed item held between the user and the manufacturer's representative. The supplier will have to depute representative for joint inspection within 10 days of intimation of warranty failure. 3. The PBG (s) shall remain valid up to a period of up to 03 months beyond the warranty period
 4. The PBG shall be submitted sufficiently in advance (say 3-4 weeks) to enable its verification from the issuing bank, before submission of the invoice.
 5. The release of the Performance Bank guarantee(s) after above indicated period, shall be subject to satisfactory performance of the equipment/ items during the warranty period and fulfillment of contractual obligations failing which, action for further extension or encashment of PBG, as deemed suitable shall be taken.
