

Govt will reopen probe into Smitarani death case: CM

The woman was murdered by local leaders of BJD: Majhi

THE state government will reopen investigation into the mysterious death of Smitarani Biswal, a panchayat executive officer of Haridaspur panchayat in Jajpur district, after five years of the incident.

This was announced by Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi at an event organised by the BJP at Barchana during the party's membership drive on Sunday. Smitarani was found hanging in a private guest house under mysterious circumstances on October 16, 2019.

Coming down heavily on the previous BJD government for not acting on crime against women due to politics, the chief minister alleged that Smitarani was murdered by the local leaders of the regional outfit and it was given the colour of a suicide.

"Smitarani's husband met me recently and requested for a fresh probe into the incident. Our government will investigate the case and take stern action against all those involved in the crime," Majhi said.

Taking a dig at the 'Maa Ku Samman' (respect to women) slogan of the BJD, he asked if killing a woman PEO to whitewash the black deeds of the local leaders of the regional party was respect to women.

The chief minister said despite many top leaders of the BJD representing the mineral-rich Jajpur district, it has lagged behind in all development indices.

Citing the Nagada malnutrition deaths during the previous govern-

ment, he said the death of 15 children showed the state in poor light and hogged headlines at national and international level. Though the then government launched several schemes to bring a change in the lives of the people at Nagada, it failed to implement them. There is hardly any change in the lives of the people of the village, he said.

"There has been only destruction in the state during the 24 years of BJD rule because of its vote bank politics. Despite being endowed with rich mineral resources, Jajpur is lagging behind due to three families who have looted the district," Majhi said.

He said Congress and BJD are two sides of the same coin so far as dynasty politics and nepotism is concerned.

"While the son has taken over the reins from mother in Congress, here in Jajpur district, sons are ruling the roost after their fathers in the BJD," he said. Their only aim is to amass wealth not the development of the people, Majhi added.

BJD disputes CM's statement on Jajpur

TAKING on Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi, the BJD demanded that he should come out with the names of the leaders who have looted Jajpur district and amassed wealth when the regional outfit was in power in the state.

Addressing a media-conference here, BJD Rajya Sabha MP Sulata Deo said that the statement of the chief minister is not based on evidence and seems to be made out of the frustration of his government's failure to achieve the target set for 100 days. Deo said contrary to what the chief minister said during the BJD tenure, Odisha transformed into the rice bowl of the country. Malnutrition in Odisha was low compared to states like Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh, she said and added that Nagada in Jajpur district has seen all-round development.

HC concerned over filing of forged documents

THE Orissa High Court has expressed serious concern over non-verification or authentication of documents by advocates and even advocate's clerks as a result of which forged documents are placed before it to get relief in cases.

While deeming such action as "severe form of contemptuous attitude", the division bench of Justice SK Sahoo and Justice Chittaranjan Dash directed the advocates or advocate's clerks to properly verify the documents before placing them on record. "It is also better to ask the party concerned to swear the affidavit," the bench said.

The observation came in a case

in which a forged school transfer certificate was used by a lawyer in an appeal by one Sanatan Hessa for re-consideration of his conviction for murder, on the basis of age-factor and quashing the trial court's order of imprisonment for life.

The advocate's clerk Dardan Sethi pleaded before the court that he carried out the instruction of the advocate and had sworn the affidavit wherein certain documents were enclosed. He had no knowledge about the genuineness of those documents and on bona fide belief and good faith, he had annexed the same to the application.

Advocate Nityananda Panda on

his part pleaded that the forged document was provided by Hessa's brother-in-law Gania Gagarai and he had accepted it on good faith as genuine and annexed the same to the application in the appeal.

The court initiated criminal contempt proceedings against Gagarai and ordered his detention. Gagarai remained in jail custody from September 3 till the proceeding was dropped after he tendered unconditional apology on September 24.

The bench, however, took stern note of the fact that forged medical documents, forged date of birth certificates and school certificates are being filed in different cases to

get relief, and most of the times, the advocate's clerks swear affidavit in filing such documents for which they are made accountable in case of any forgery.

Accordingly, the bench said, "It is the responsibility of the advocate and the advocate's clerks to bring correct state of affairs before the court and their attempt should not be to misguide the court in any manner. If the advocate or the advocate's clerk has no personal knowledge about a particular document which is produced by a party, then it is to be verified properly before bringing the same on record and it is also better to ask the concerned party to swear the affidavit."

After BJP, BJD sets target to enrol more than one crore members

AMID the ongoing membership drive of the BJP with a target to bring more than one crore people of the state into its fold, rival BJD is all set to launch its own campaign with similar enrolment goals from October 9. The two-month-long drive will be launched by party president Naveen Patnaik.

Announcing this at a media-conference here on Sunday, chairman of the BJD steering committee Debi Prasad Mishra said the focus will be on enrolling more youths and students. The party has constituted a 21-member committee headed by former minister Atanu Sabayasachi Nayak to achieve the target fixed by the party supremo. The effort will be to consolidate the existing members and bring in new members, he said.

Mishra said the committee has decided to launch membership drive in the digital mode in a big way this time. Besides, public meetings will also be

held at panchayat, block and Assembly constituency level to enrol members. Party MLAs, defeated candidates in last elections and local leaders have been given a major role to achieve the target, he said.

Naveen has written a letter to all MPs, MLAs, district presidents and other leaders in this regard. The annual Jana Sampark Padayatra of the party will be also held for 15 days in two phases from October 2. The failure of the state government in fulfilling election promises should be highlighted during the padayatra, the party supremo has said.

The padayatra should also be used to highlight decline in law and order situation and increase in crime against women, failure of the government to control price of essential commodities and halting all welfare works launched by the BJD government.

All activities during the padayatra should be synchronised to boost the membership drive, Naveen has instructed the party leaders.

The committee has decided to launch membership drive in the digital mode in a big way this time. Besides, public meetings will also be held at panchayat, block and Assembly constituency level to enrol members.
