# RSP making efforts for zero accident unit

ROURKELA Steel Plant (RSP) has been making all out efforts to become an accident free Steel producing unit of the country.

Recently 'Sankalp - A new Safety Intervention,' was started to strengthen the safety initiatives at RSP through Behavior based Safety (BBS) model. As a part of it a massive two day campaign named as "Bhai-Bhauni, Bandhu Suraksha," was launched on 27th May.

CEO Dipak Chattaraj, inaugurated the campaign at HRD Centre on Monday morning which was conducted by renowned behavioral scientist Dr. Harbans Lal Kaila.

Earlier a field visit was organized in which around 50 Departmental Safety Officers, Area Safety Officers and personnel of Safety Department made observations on the behavioral pattern of the employees of the plant with the help of BBS Observation Card. This was



based on the conceptual input provided in the forenoon session.

The findings of this session were analysed and another session was held in the afternoon to chalk out an implementation strategy. The nine areas of behavioral concerns that were zeroed in on were Personal Protection Equipment (PPE), house-keeping, using of tools and equipments, body positioning, material handling, verbal and non-verbal communication, attentiveness and use of mobile phone while working.

The eight pronged strategy finalized to address these issues include parikrama (going around), prashna (questioning), Prashansa (praising), parivartan (conversion), prashikshan (training), pratigya (pledge), prachar (teach) and prarthana (request).

This interaction was followed by

a motivational session in Gopabandhu auditorium that was attended by around 450 employees from across the plant including senior officers.

Addressing the gathering Kaila laid emphasis on right observation, spot correction and spot reward. He also laid stress on the concept of moving from awareness to alertness.

A short documentary "Maine Anya Disha Mein Dekhna Pasand Kiya," on BBS concept was screened on the occasion.

The function commenced with the Welcome Address by Mr. Subrat Acharya, DGM I/c(SEF). This was followed by a Safety Pledge taken by all present. Mr. Ram Narayan Nayak, GM(C&IT) proposed a vote of thanks.

Nivedita Roy, DGM, HRD anchored the programme while Swaroop Panigrahi, DGM(HRD) facilitated the sessions.

On Tuesday similar sessions were organized at the HRD Centre for 100 contract labour and 100 Frontline Executives and Sectional Safety In-charge officers.

The Menstrual

Menstrual Hygiene Day is an annual awareness day observed on May 28 to highlight the importance of good menstrual hygiene management. The day was initiated by a German-based NGO WASH United in 2014 and aims to benefit bleeding persons worldwide.

May 28 was selected to acknowledge that 28 days is the average length of the menstrual cycle.
