Das said the state government has proposed the Centre not to make Aadhaar card mandatory for the patients seeking to undergo treatment at government hospitals.

"The Aadhaar card can be made mandatory for private hospitals," he said, adding that under the BSKY there is no such provision of mandatory Aadhaar card for getting treatment.

The health minister further said the Centre has decided to cover 62 lakh beneficiaries Avushman Bharat for treatment at private hospitals, but the state government has asked to raise it to 70 lakh.

"The state government has already apprised the Centre of its two conditions in a letter in September and December last year. But there has been no response till date," Das said.
