

Odisha Mahila Cong chief Sumitra Jena quits party

In a jolt to the opposition Congress ahead of the polls, Odisha Pradesh Mahila Congress president Sumitra Jena Tuesday resigned from the party.

"I have resigned from the post of Mahila Congress president as well as from the primary membership of the party," Jena told reporters here.

She accused the Odisha Pradesh Congress Committee (OPCC) president Niranjan Patnaik of ignoring women while

selecting candidates for the Lok Sabha and Assembly elections.

Jena also accused the OPCC president of fielding weak candidates against the ruling BJD candidates.

Expressing discontent over being denied a party ticket to contest from the Bhadrak assembly seg-

ment, Jena said, "I was an aspirant for the Bhadrak assembly seat, but the party ticket went to someone who was not even a primary member of the party," Jena said.

The Congress has fielded Nalinikant Mohanty from the Bhadrak assembly seat against BJDs Sanjeev Mallick and BJP's Pradeep Naik.

Launching a scathing attack on Patnaik, who is contesting from two assembly segments - Ghshipura in Keonjhar district and Bhandaripokhari in Bhadrak district, Jena said, "The OPCC president has

also fielded his son from the Balasore Lok Sabha seat."

Jena also lashed out at party chief Niranjan Patnaik for his dynasty politics and restricting women empowerment in politics.

"Patnaik has become the OPCC president to take revenge of his removal from the post in 2012. His leadership will further weaken Congress," Jena said.

Jena also criticised Patnaik for not taking action against the miscreants who manhandled her at the state party headquarters a few days ago.

Dissidence affects parties' campaign in dhenkanal

AFTER deadline for withdrawal over in Dhenkanal Assembly constituency on Tuesday, three major political parties—Congress, BJD and BJP—have intensified their campaign with different strategies to win voters in their favour.

The three major political party candidates are former MLAs and a triangular high voltage contest is on the cards in the constituency.

Three former MLAs — Nabin Nanda [Congress], Sudhir Kumar Samal [BJD] and Krushna Chandra Patra [BJP] are in the fray.

Among these three, Samal is richest candidate which he has declared during his nomination. He has shown property worth crores of rupees in his wife's name and in Government records.

He switched allegiance from Congress to the ruling party [BJD] months before election. Samal is trying to concentrate in Gondia Block where his base is not so strong.

The Block, comprising 29 GPs and nearly 1.45 lakh voters.

Samal is confident of victory banking on the image of party supremo and Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik and the ground work done by former MLA Nabin Nanda at booth level.

Samal has begun road shows and rallies by uniting young voters and youth coming from Dhenkanal to Gondia Block highlighting the development programmes of BJD government.

However, many local BJD func-

tionaries have either resigned from the party or maintaining distance from Samal.

Nanda, meanwhile, has intensified door to door campaign now as earlier he has already finished ground works by organizing village and booth level meetings.

Nanda has raised local issues in his campaign and public meetings. Issues like upgradation of Bapur and Joranda hospitals, setting up of court in Gondia, irrigation facilities and the poor performance of State Government in agricultural and horticultural sectors.

Nanda claims his party workers and villagers have contributed to his election funds.

He says his workers and supporters work mostly in Gondia area.

Nanda is also hopeful of the support of BJP dissident leaders as they had extended support during Zilla Parishad formation.

On the other hand, BJP candidate Krushna Chandra Patra has faced dissidence from within party as senior leaders have maintained distance from him after being sidelined by party.

Patra has started organizing workers meet and meeting people in Gondia while his brother and BJP leader Ram Chandra Patra has started meeting people in Dhenkanal municipality areas.

Patra is emphasizing on change of guard at state level and highlighting works of Modi-led government.

Former Rajya Sabha Member and Lok Sabha candidate Rudra Narayan Pany is jointly organizing public meetings in Dhenkanal Assembly constituency with trust on Gondia voters.

Raseswari seeks people's cooperation for Sambalpur's progress

SAMBALPUR: Dr. Raseswari Panigrahi, the sitting MLA of Sambalpur who is trying her luck at the hustings for the second time, on Tuesday appealed the voters to support her to ensure development of Sambalpur.

"My first tenure for five years was a successful one. I have done a lot for Sambalpur, and my further dream is more development," said Panigrahi while talking to the media persons here.

She, accompanied by all the senior leaders of the party, released a list of the works she has done in the first tenure and her plans for future if the people bless her.

A world class bus stand to a planetarium, and also the second Mahanadi bridge are few among the major works of the BJD government with total support from the Chief Minister in the last five years, she said.

The other works are Odisha State Open University, autonomous status to VSSIMSAR, mega pump houses for discharge of water from Sambalpur city during rainy season, beautification of the ring road with decorative lightning, modernization of the JK Sahu swimming pool up to an international standard, widening and beautification of the Burla and Hirakud townships, and many others, she informed.

Notably, after delimitation; Sambalpur constituency now has three major towns—Sambalpur, Burla and Hirakud with a large population.

Panigrahi gave a list of developmental works in all 37 wards of the corporation area. —PBD

Tough contest in Assembly segments of Cuttack Lok Sabha constituency

TWO times Sansad Ratna awardee and Biju Janata Dal candidate Bhartruhari Mahata is set to face a tough fight from heavyweights of BJP and Congress—former DGP Prakash Mishra and Panchanan Kanungo respectively this time here.

Mahtab is getting elected from Cuttack constituency since 1998 polls.

There are seven Assembly segments coming under this Parliamentary constituency like Baramba, Banki, Athagarh, Barabati-Cuttack, Choudwar-Cuttack, Cuttack Sadar and Khandapada.

As a Lok Sabha candidate, Mahtab requires the support of the Assembly segments. During the last four elections he won almost effortlessly as the BJD had wide popularity in the area.

Mahatab is facing difficul-

ties in the area as he was allegedly never accessible to people from his constituency and whenever anyone met him, he insisted on coming through the local MLA.

"Come through proper channel," was his reply, said people in the constituency.

With the political scenario in the State now changed, with increasing popularity of Prime Minister Narendra Modi after the successful air strikes on Balakote as answer to the Pulwama terror attack, Athagarh is also feeling the impact.

Anti-incumbency factor also appears to have come into play as people have a lot of grievances which were not addressed in the past 19 years, say analysts.

This apart, selection of family members of chit fund scam tainted BJD leaders such as Pravat Tripathy in Banki and Prabhat Biswal in Choudwar-Cuttack constituency — segments of Cuttack Parliament constituency—has not

gone well with the people.

BJD has chosen Tripathy and Biswal's sons—Devirajan and Souvik—who are virtual novices in politics and the voters are not convinced with their selection.

The senior workers of the party appear disoriented with their selection, admitted a senior worker who did not want to be identified.

In Athagarh Assembly constituency, the candidate Ranendra Pratap Swain also does not appear keen about the Lok Sabha candidate as he is busy consolidating his own position.

In Badamba segment, the panchayat election had given verdict in favour of BJP while in Cuttack-Barabati constituency Debasish Samantray is finding difficulties for allegedly assaulting a martyr's kin.

In Cuttack Sadar, the position of BJD candidate Chandrasarathi Behera is also not encouraging while reports suggest Mahatab is ahead in Khandapada segment.

Political equations may change in J'singhpur LS segment

PARADIP: WITH Bibhu Prasad Tarai in the fray for the Jagatsinghpur Lok Sabha seat on a BJP ticket and standing MLA Rajashree Mallick facing him as a contestant in place of the standing BJD MP Kulamani Samal, experts feel political equations in this reserved Parliamentary constituency may change this time.

One of the 21 Parliamentary constituencies of Odisha, Jagatsinghpur Lok Sava Constituency (ST) was formed prior to the 1977 elections, comprising seven Assembly segments.

The segments are Niali (SC), Paradip, Tirtol(SC),

Balikuda-Erasama, Jagatsinghpur, Kakatpur(SC) and Nimapara.

According to 2009 data the total electorates in the Jagatsinghpur Parliamentary constituency was 14,55,406 of which 69,1294 were females and 76,4112 were males.

In 2014 election, BJD MP candidate Kulamani Samal won the seat polling 6,24,492 votes whereas Congress candidate Bibhu Prasad Tarai managed to garner 3,48,098 votes taking the second position.

BJP candidate Baidhar Mallick had got 1,17,448 votes coming third.

Tarai was elected MP

from Jagatsinghpur in 2009 on a CPI ticket when the BJD had a seat sharing arrangement with the Left.

He had joined the Congress ahead of the 2014 elections and had unsuccessfully contested the 2014 Lok Sabha poll.

Tarai had finished second by polling 3.48 lakh votes while Kulamani Samal of the BJD had won with a whooping margin, polling a total 6.24 lakh votes.

Besides Tarai from the BJP, Tirtol's standing BJD MLA Rajashree Mallick and Pratima Mallick of Congress are going to contest from this MP segment this time. —PBD

BJP files complaint against 'Bijubabu', pleads it's impacting voters

BJP Tuesday demanded withdrawal of 'Bijubabu' film playing in all cinema halls across the State since March 1, claiming that the film is impacting voters in favour of the Biju Janata Dal.

In a written complaint submitted to the Chief Electoral Officer, the party said the film, Bijubabu, portrays the life of Biju Patnaik who was a popular leader of Odisha. The Biju Janata Dal is also named after him, it added.

The complaint alleged that Anubhav Mohanty who is Lok

Sabha candidate on BJD ticket from Kendrapara Lok Sabha seat is also playing the role of Bijubabu in the film.

"It is an attempt by the ruling BJD to influence the innocent voters in its favour in the current elections and it is an offence under Section 171 (c) and 171 (f) of the IPC. The film is being used as a propaganda instrument of the BJD," the delegation alleged and demanded its immediate withdrawal from the cinemas.

The delegation comprised BJP State secretary Dr. Lekhashree Samantsinghar, Election Cell coordinator Jayant Jena and party's Yuv Morcha State vice-president Sikandar Ali.
