SORCERER BITES TO CURE FEVER

Witch doctor swears he had cured victims of dog, snake bites using the same method

SUPERSTITIONS continue to hold sway in tribal belts of the State as people still believe sorcerers possess the power to cure illness and diseases.

In a shocking incident, a 38-year-old woman was bitten by a sorcerer all over her body to cure her fever in the tribal-dominated Kalimela block of Mayurbhanj district on Monday.

Sources said Dule Beti of Urmaguda village in Telarai panchayat within Kalimela police limits was suffering from high fever since the last three days. She also showed signs of shivering and developed severe stomach ache. However, instead of visiting a doctor, she approached a local sorcerer named Kosa Beti.

After performing some rituals and chanting mantras in the local language, Kosa gave a herbal portion to Dule. He also started fanning her with a peacock feather. Then to everyone's shock, Kosa started biting the ailing woman's body at different places and claimed that this will cure her fever. The sorcerer swore that he had cured victims of dog bites and snake bites using the same method.

Following the incident, some locals alleged that since medical teams are not able to reach their village, they have no option but to depend on the sorcerers. On the other hand, Anganwadi workers said superstitions still prevailed in the village due to which many lives have been lost. Ailing villagers seek proper medical help only at the last moment, they added.

Soro woman alleges triple talaq

CLOSE on the heels of a triple talaq case in Bhograi, another Muslim woman of Pathana Mahala village within Soro police limits in the district on Tuesday approached Collector K Sudharsan Chakravarty accusing her husband of giving her instant divorce when she requested for money to celebrate Bakrid.

The victim, identified as 24-year-old Reso Khatun, met

the Collector when the latter was hearing grievances of the public at Soro block office. Chakravarty has directed Soro IIC Khyamasagar Panda to register a case and initiate a probe into it.

Reso said she married Sahim Khan, a businessman, as per Muslim rituals on May 2, 2016. Her father Nasir Khan, a resident of Haripur within Agarpada police limits in Bhadrak, had given ₹80,000 as dowry along with furniture and ornaments worth ₹2 lakh

to Sahim's family and spent a total of ₹8 lakh in the marriage. However just one year after the marriage, her husband allegedly developed a love affair with his uncle's daughter. Sahim started to torture her both mentally and physically. He warned her to go away from his life as he wanted to marry the girl. Even his family members did not support her and tortured her, Reso alleged.

Despite facing the hardships, Reso lived in her in-laws' house. In the meantime, she was forced to abort her pregnancy at four months. The woman further alleged that she was forced to leave her in-laws' house after her husband and his family members tried to kill her by pressing a pillow on her face one night. Though she returned back after a few days, her husband did not allow her to enter his house. Reso had to spend an entire night in the open and the next morning, she forcefully entered her in-laws' house and

started living there. "I have been living in dark as my husband disconnected the power supply to my room," she claimed. Reso said a meeting was held between her family and her in-laws in the local police station but in vain. On Monday when she went to her husband's shop to seek money for celebrating Bakrid, Sahim abused her and uttered talaq three times, she alleged.

Damaged NH stretch repair sought

Jeyapore: Transporters and citizen forums of Jeyapore and Korapat have demanded immediate repair of a damaged stretch of the NH between Korapat and Borrigumma. In a statement, they said hundreds of potholes have been created on the 45-km stretch of the NH following recent rains. Commuters are facing a lot of difficulties due to the damaged road. They urged the NHAI to fill these potholes at the earliest.

3 criminals arrested

Jeyapore: Borrigumma police arrested three notorious criminals from Kundraguda area here. Acting on a tip off that five anti-socials were planning to loot passersby, a police patrolling team reached the spot. While two managed to escape, three were nabbed. Police seized about 50 gm of gold, ₹35,000 and weapons from their possession. The three have 11 cases pending against them in Jeyapore, Kotpad, Borrigumma and Kundra police stations. Efforts are on to nab the other two criminals.

Students stage dharna in front of block office against school merger

STUDENTS of Kapurabelli primary school along with their guardians staged dharna in front of Balikuda block office here on Tuesday protesting merger of their school in "violation of the rationalisation policy".

Earlier, the School and Mass Education department had merged Bagheipur Primary School (Satellite school) in Barmunduli panchayat with Kapurabelli school (lead school) on June 13 as the former had only nine students. Two teachers of Bagheipur were also transferred to Kapurabelli School. The students of Bagheipur even took admission in Kapurabelli school.

However, villagers of Bagheipur later did not send their children to Kapurabelli school as it was situated two km away from their village. They started the Bagheipur school by engaging a private lady teacher.

On July 22, the district education office, however, modified the merger of the two schools in view of availability of better infrastructure facilities in Bagheipur. Bagheipur primary school, despite having only nine students, was treated as the lead school while the one at Kapurabelli, with 29 students, became the satellite school. The Kapurabelli school was locked and its four teachers

joined Bagheipur school. Protesting the move, villagers of Kapurabelli have been running their school by engaging three private teachers since the last 15 days. Collector Sangram Keshari Mohapatra, who was present in Balikuda block office for hearing grievances of locals, assured the agitating students of resolving the issue within seven days following which the protest was called off.

Youth held for recording obscene video

Baripada: Baripada police arrested a 20-year-old youth for recording a video of a minor girl while she was taking bath on Monday night. A mobile phone and memory card were seized from the accused Sonu Patra, son of Rabintra Patra of Kumbhar Mundhakote within Bangiriposi police limits. SDPO K P Pattanaik said Sonu, a daily wage labourer, was staying on rent at the house of Ashok Mohanty at Punasahi locality of the town adjoining the residence of the victim. He recorded the video of the minor on his mobile phone from the roof of the bathroom after cracking a tile. The girl became suspicious after she saw the flash of the cell phone and also identified the accused. Her brother lodged a complaint against Sonu following which the latter was arrested. Pattanaik said the accused had made videos and clicked objectionable photographs of several women of the locality in the past. He said the memory card seized from the accused will be sent to forensic laboratory for examination. The accused was remanded in judicial custody after his bail plea was rejected, the SDPO said.
