

PM unveils projects worth over ₹1,550 crore in Odisha

PRIME Minister Narendra Modi Tuesday launched a slew of central government projects worth over Rs 1,550 crore in Odisha and said they would play a key role in accelerating the state's development.

Affirming the Centre's resolve to expand connectivity in Odisha, he said education, coupled with connectivity, would lead to speedy development and overall progress of all sections of the society.

"I am happy to unveil projects worth Rs 1,550 crore in areas like education, connectivity, tourism and culture," Modi said while inaugurating and laying foundation stone for a series of projects, mainly in the railway sector, at a function here.

During his third visit to Odisha in as many weeks, the prime minister dedicated to the nation the electrification of Jharsuguda-Vizianagaram and Sambalpur-Angul railway lines spanning 813 km, which have been completed at a cost of Rs 1,085 crore.

The project aims to ensure seamless rail connectivity on the line and reduce journey time. It will also reduce diesel consumption and greenhouse gas emission, a senior railway official said.

Modi also inaugurated the doubling of 14.2 km Barpali-



Dungaripali and 17.3 km Balangir-Deogano rail lines, completed at a cost of Rs 189.3 crore. They are part of the Rs 18.54 km Sambalpur-Titlagarh doubling project.

Describing connectivity as a catalyst for progress, Modi said it would boost trade, commerce and tourism, besides helping farmers in taking their produce to the markets.

Strong connectivity would also propel industrialisation, which in turn would create enormous opportunities for employment generation, he said.

A Multi-Modal Logistics Park (MMLP) at Jharsuguda, built at a cost of Rs 100 crore, was dedicated to the nation by the prime minister.

The line would connect coastal Odisha with western region through Sonepur, Boudh, Puranakatak, Daspalla and Nayagarh, synchronising development across the state.

The line would connect off a new train on Balangir-Bichhupali route which would benefit commuters of the region, besides connecting Bichhupali to Jharsuguda and Vizianagaram main line through Balangir.

A bridge between Theruvali and Singapur Road station, constructed at a cost of Rs 27.4 crore, was inaugurated on the occasion. The bridge reestablishes the linkage over Nagavali river, which was washed away during floods in July 2017.

These apart, Modi inaugurated renovation and restoration works at Nilamadhav & Siddhavas Temple at Gandaharadi in Boudh, Paschim Sonmth group of temples, also in Boudh, and

Ranipur Jharia group of monuments in Balangir, an official of the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) said.

He inaugurated six Passport Seva Kendras (PSKs) at Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Puri, Phulbani, Bargarh and Balangir through video conferencing.

The PSKs would immensely benefit the people as they would no longer require to travel all the way to Bhubaneswar for getting passports issued, Modi said.

The prime minister laid the foundation stone for a permanent building of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Sonepur, to be constructed at a cost of Rs 15.81 crore and also inaugurated a Kendriya Vidyalaya at Rayagada.

He said the Centre has been worried - what has happened to this government? Is it sleeping? he lashed out, but refrained from naming the name of either the ruling BJP or Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik during his 47 minute-long speech.

Modi's visit to the western Odisha town on Tuesday assumes significance in light of the upcoming Assembly and general elections. He toured Bhubaneswar and Khurda on December 24 and launched Rs 14,523 crore worth of projects for Odisha, while on his visit to Baripada on January 5 he unveiled programmes worth Rs 4,733 crore.

Don't wait for elections to spend public money: Modi tells Odisha govt

PRIME Minister Narendra Modi Tuesday asked the Odisha government not to wait for elections to undertake developmental activities in the state.

He also attacked the State government for its "inability" to spend Rs 4,000 crore lying with the District Mineral Foundations (DMF) and development of the mining areas.

"Do not wait till elections, they will come and go. Resolve the problems of poor and work for their development," he said.

"You have money in hand to undertake developmental activities," Modi said while addressing a huge gathering in this western Odisha town after launching several projects.

"I am worried - what has happened to this government? Is it sleeping?" he lashed out, but refrained from naming the name of either the ruling BJP or Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik during his 47 minute-long speech.

The Prime Minister said for the first time in the country, the BJP government had made provisions for the development of mining areas inhibited by tribals.

Working for 'Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas' (collective efforts, inclusive growth), the BJP government has given priority to tribal development. In the past though there has been huge earning from mining operations,

the mineral belts used to be neglected and the people there were poverty-stricken, he said.

Stating that DMF was people's money and mandated to be spent for the welfare of those inhabiting the mining areas, predominantly tribals, Modi said the state government should fully utilise the funds for them.

He also highlighted the development projects launched by him during his three visits to the state in as many weeks.

"In a month, more than Rs 20,000 crore of development projects have been either inaugurated or initiated in Odisha. Projects worth more than Rs 1,500 crore in sectors like education, connectivity, culture and tourism that were launched today will not only spur the growth of the state, but also of eastern India," he said.

This apart, Modi said his government has allocated about Rs 20,000 crore in the railways sector in the state during the last four-and-a-half years. This is five times more than the funds allocated by any other government in the past, he said.

BJD, Cong rebut Modi's criticism

ALL agencies of the Odisha government are working in tandem to ensure that the projects targeted rural areas reach the beneficiaries on time and in an effective manner, Finance Department Minister, Sashi Bhushan Behera said responding to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's allegations that the Central funds are not being utilised by the State government.

He said that Modi is not aware of the facts and figures at the grassroots.

"The manner in which KALIA, PEETHA and other schemes of the State government are being prioritised, can be understood only if our leaders travel to the far-flung villages," added Behera. PCC president Niranjan Patnaik said that Modi was claiming credit for the railway projects in Odisha which were initiated during the UPA government. Railway projects are ongoing works. It was during the Congress government that the Bolangir railway projects were started and now the BJP government is taking credit and trying to misguide the people of this state, he said. SC and ST Development Minister Ramesh Majhi alleged that since 2013-14 the funds for the development of the scheduled caste and scheduled tribe students have kept on reducing. "What funds is the Prime Minister talking about? The Central funds meant for the stipend of SC and ST students have been nearly struck off. First let him earmark those funds and then pose questions," he said.
