

PM unveils projects worth over ₹1,550 crore in Odisha

BALANGIR, JAN 15

PRIME Minister Narendra Modi Tuesday launched a slew of central govern-ment projects worth over Rs 1,550 crore in Odisha and said they would play a key role in accelerating the state's develop-ment.

Affirming the Centre's resolve to expand connectivity in Odisha, he said education, coupled with connectivity would lead to speedy development and overall progress of all sections of the society.

"I am happy to unveil projects worth 8s 1,550 crore in areas like education, connectivity, tourism and culture," Modi said while inaugurating and laying foundation stone for a series of projects, mainly in the railway sector, at a function here.

During his third visit to Odisha in as many weeks, the prime minister dedicated to the nation the electrification of plarsuguda-Vizianagaram and Sambalpur-Angul railway lines spanning 813 km, which have been completed at a cost of 8s 1,085 crore.

The project aims to ensure seamless rail connectivity on the line and reduce journey time. It will also reduce diesel con-sumption and greenhouse gas emission, a senior railway offi-

Modi also inaugurated the doubling of 14.2 km Barpali-

Describing connectivity as a catalyst for progress, Modi said it would boost trade, commerce and tourism, besides helping farmers in taking their produce to the mandis.

Strong connectivity would also propel industrialisation, which in turn would create enormous opportunities for employment generation, he said.

Park (MMLP) at Jharsuguda,
built at a cost of Rs 100 crore,

He also inaugurated the 15-km-long Balangir-Bichhupali ailway line laid at a cost of Rs 115 crore. It is part of the new 289-km Balangir-Khurla Road line which connects to Howrah-Chemnal main line on Khurda coadside and Titlagarh-Sambalpur line at Balangir.

The line would connect coastal Odisha with western region through Sonepur, Boudh, Puranakatak, Daspalla and Nayagarh, synchronising development across the state.

The line would also benefit many micro, small and medium relternises and, cottage indus-

many micro, small and medium enterprises and cottage indus-

tries, and generate opportuni-

tries, and generate opportunities for the mining sector.

The prime minister flagged off a new train on Balangirichupali route which would benefit commuters of the region, besides connecting Bichhupali to Jharsuguda and Vizianagaram main line through Balangir.

A bridge between Theruvali and Singapur Road station, constructed at a cost of RS 27.4 crore, was inaugurated on the occasion. The bridge reestablishes the linkage over Nagavali river, which was washed away during floods in July 2017.

He inaugurated six Passport Seva Kendras (PSKs) at Jagatsinghpur, Kendrapara, Puri, Phulbani, Bargarh and Balangir through video conferencing.

The prime minister laid the foundation stone for a permanent building of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Sonepur, to be constructed at a cost of Rs 15.81 crore and also inaugurated a Kendriya Vidyalaya at Rayagada.

He said the Centre has been taking concrete steps for spreading the Kendriya Vidyalaya network in Odisha and the new schools would play a significant role in human resource development in the state.

Modi's visit to the western Odisha town on Tuesday assumes significance in light of the upcoming Assembly and general elections.

He toured Bhubaneswar and Khurda on December 24 and launched Rs 14.523 crore

"You have money in hand to undertake developmental activities," Modi said while addressing a huge gathering in this western Odisha town after launching several projects. "I am worried - what happened to this government? Is it sleeping?" he lashed out, but ferfained from taking the name of either the ruling BID or Chief Minister Navene Patnaik during his 47 minute-long speech.

The Prime Minister said for the first time in the country, the BJP government had made provisions for the development of mining areas inhabited by tribals.

Working for Sab ka Sath, Sab Ka Vilkas' (collective efforts, inclusive growth), the BJP government has given priority to tribal development. In the past though there has been luge earning from mining operations,

the mineral belts used to be neg-lected and the people there were poverty-stricken, he said. Stating that DMF was peo-ple's money and mandated to be spent for the welfare of those inhabiting the mining areas, pre-dominantly tribals, Modi said the state ooverment should
