

Govt rubbishes Opposition charge of failure in paddy procurement

STATE Food Supplies & Consumer Welfare, Cooperation Minister Ranendra Pratap Swain Tuesday rubbished charges of the opposition that the State government has totally failed in the procurement of paddy.

Replying to an adjournment motion moved by Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) members Jayanarayan Mishra, Mukesh Mahaling and Shankar Oram, the Minister said that motion moved by the members is not based on facts.

Giving details of the Paddy Procurement Policy for the current 2019-20 and arrangements made, Swain informed the House that district administration/procurement agencies are taking adequate measures to prevent distress sale of paddy.

He said paddy procurement for the Kharif season has taken off in western Odisha districts of Bargarh,



Sambalpur, etc. and will take place in other districts in accordance with harvesting time.

"As of now, message through SMS has been sent to 20,738 farmers of Bargarh, Kalahandi, Sambalpur, Subarnapur, Nuapada, and Bolangir districts to remain present with a total 15,06,375 quintal paddy on the specified date at the specified mandi. SMS has been sent to the registered mobile number of the registered farmers well in advance before paddy procurement. List of the advance token is also available at the offices of procurement societies/Women SHGs.

Farmers can also collect tokens as per the SMS from society/Block Development offices and bring their paddy to mandis for procurement," the Minister informed the House.

He said that for the first time in the current year, process for issue of tokens has been freed from human intervention; it is being done through fully computerized system.

Swain stated that the token system has been introduced in the interest of the farmers and added that it will streamline sale-purchase at the mandis while freeing farmers from uncertainty and apprehensions.

The Minister said that

the State government has taken steps to make paddy procurement technology-driven, transparent, timely, accountable and effective and disciplined.

Not satisfied with the Minister's reply BJP members staged a walkout.

Meanwhile, a release from the Chief Minister's Office said that the farmers will get their tokens on their registered mobile numbers. The list will also be published at the PACS.

Earlier the tokens were generated by the PACS which was not a transparent process and some farmers were the preferred ones. Hence this is not the first time that token system has been introduced. Only now the tokens will be issued in a more inclusive and transparent manner.

This system allows small and marginal farmers to bring paddy for sale since tokens are issued in a transparent way. Hence the system will not be dominated by big farmers.

It said the traders cannot enter the system as the

experience shows that some PACS first try to adjust traders paddy and genuine farmers have to wait to sell their paddy.

The PACS will have no control on the system. As a result farmers will not face harassment in the hands of PACS officials, the release asserted.

The State Government has also decided to control the flow of paddy from neighboring state and if a farmer fails to sell his paddy when token is issued then he/she need not worry as token will be issued to him/her again.

The release said that Aadhaar will be the identification and exempted aged, infirm or women to come as their paddy will be purchased in unauthenticated mode and field verified later.

Stalemate continues in Bargarh, Sambalpur on paddy sale through online token

THE Stalemate over paddy procurement through online token system continued in Sambalpur and Bargarh districts on Tuesday.

Farmers and the district administration are moving on parallel tracks.

In Bargarh, a meeting was held between the administration and farmers to bring about a solution. But farmers and their leaders did not agree to sell paddy through online token system while demanding the earlier system.

They argued that the old system will not cause any problem for any farmer-big or small.

However, the Collector insisted said that the token system would put an end to many irregularities and corruption.

"At the same time, it



would end the Dalalraj," he said.

"Those farmers who attended today's meeting agreed to sell paddy through the online token system as it aims at bringing transparency," the collector further said. "Farmers realised the advantage of token system," he added.

In Sambalpur the farmers kept paddy loaded in vehicles in front

of the houses of the MLA here in protest.

"These leaders came to us and assured that they would raise the issue in the assembly. But they did nothing for us and kept silent at the state capital," alleged Ashok Pradhan.

Police were deployed in front of the houses of Rohit Pujari, Nauri Naik and Jayanarayan Mishra at Brookshills, Bhatra and Nandpara respectively.
