India, Japan talk semiconductors

Japanese chip makers plan to tie up with India

Tokyo, August 30

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday visited a semiconductor plant at Sendai in the Japanese prefecture of Miyagi, a day after New Delhi and Tokyo resolved to deepen cooperation in the critical technology sector.

Modi, accompanied by his Japanese counterpart Shigeru Ishiba, travelled in a bullet train to Sendai, situated at a distance of over 300 km from Tokyo. Prime Minister Ishiba hosted a lunch in honour of Modi in Sendai that was joined by the governor of Miyagi prefecture and other dignitaries. PM Modi's visit to the Tokyo Electron Miyagi Ltd (TEL Miyagi) in Sendai highlighted the complementarity between India's growing semiconductor manufacturing ecosystem and Japan's strengths in the sector, an Indian readout said.

TEL Miyagi, a leading Japanese company in the semiconductor sector, has plans for collaborations with India. Modi was briefed about TEL's role in the global semiconductor value chain, its advanced manufacturing capabilities and its ongoing and planned collaborations with India.

The visit gave the leaders a practical understanding of the opportunities that exist between the two countries to

forge collaboration in the field of semiconductor supply chain, fabrication and testing, the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said in the readout.

"Both sides reaffirmed their commitment to deepening cooperation in this sector, building on the Memorandum of Cooperation on the Japan-India

semiconductor supply chain partnership as well as ongoing partnerships under the India-Japan Industrial Competitiveness Partnership and Economic Security Dialogue," it said. It said the joint visit by Modi and Ishiba to the facility also underscored the shared vision of India and Japan to develop robust, resilient and trusted semiconductor supply chains.

"Prime Minister Modi conveyed his appreciation to Prime Minister Ishiba for joining him in this visit and reaffirmed India's readiness to work closely with Japan in this strategic domain," the MEA said. On Saturday, Modi met governors of 16 Japanese prefectures in Tokyo and called for strengthening state-prefecture cooperation under the India-Japan Special Strategic and Global Partnership as well.

Japanese PM gifted Indian handicrafts

During his visit to the country, Modi presented Ishiba's wife with a pashmina shawl in a papier mache box. Officials said the vintage precious stone bowls set with silver chopsticks are a blend of Indian artistry and Japanese culinary tradition, and draws inspiration from Japan's donburi and soba rituals. The moonstone is sourced from Andhra Pradesh, while the base of the main bowl is makrana marble inlaid with semi-precious stones in the traditional parchin kari style of Rajasthan. The Pashmina shawl, is handwoven by Kashmiri artisans. These shawls are valued worldwide for being light, soft, and warm. —PTI

Refunding import taxes may prove a blow to US Treasury

PRESIDENT DONALD TRUMP has audaciously claimed virtually unlimited power to bypass Congress and impose sweeping taxes on foreign products.

Now a federal appeals court has thrown a roadblock in his path. The ruling was a big setback for Trump, whose erratic trade policies have rocked financial markets, paralysed businesses with uncertainty and raised fears of higher prices and slower economic growth. Which tariffs did the court knock down? The court's decision centres on the tariffs Trump slapped in April on almost all US trading partners and levies he imposed before that on China, Mexico and Canada.

Trump on April 2 imposed

so-called reciprocal tariffs of up to 50% on countries with which the US runs a trade deficit and 10% baseline tariffs on almost everybody else.

The president later suspended the reciprocal tariffs for 90 days to give countries time to negotiate trade agreements with the US.

The court challenge does not cover other Trump tariffs, including levies on foreign steel, aluminum and autos that the Commerce Department investigations concluded that those imports were threats to US

national security.

The government has argued that if Trump's tariffs are struck down, it might have to refund some of the import taxes that it's collected, delivering a financial blow to the US Treasury. Revenue from tariffs totalled \$159 billion by July, more than double what it was at the same point the year before. Indeed, the Justice Department warned in a legal filing this month that revoking the tariffs could mean "financial ruin" for the US. India bids to host 2030 Commonwealth Games

INDIA HAS SUBMITTED a bid to host the 2030 Commonwealth Games in Ahmedabad, hoping it will bolster its credentials to stage the 2036 Olympic Games, the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) said.

An IOA delegation submitted the bid proposal at the Commonwealth Sport headquarters in London on Friday. "This is not just a bid to stage a sporting event — it is our commitment to the Commonwealth family to deliver Games that are athlete-centred, inclusive, sustainable, and future-facing," IOA Execu-

tive Council member Harpal Singh said in a telephone call from London.

"Our vision is to use this milestone not only to honour the past but to set the stage for the future — ensuring the Games remain relevant, impactful and viable for the next century," India's federal government on Wednesday gave the go-ahead to sign the Host Collaboration Agreement (HCA).

Singh, also a member of the sports committee of Commonwealth Sport, called it a "proud moment", which took India closer to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's "vision of bringing the Olympic Games 2036 to India."

India for peaceful conflict resolution: PM to Zelensky

efforts to end the conflict in Ukraine. In a phone conversation initiated by Zelensky, Modi reaffirmed India's steadfast and consistent position for peaceful settlement of the conflict. The conversation came

two-days ahead of Modi's meeting with Russian President Vladimir Putin on the sidelines of a summit of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) in this Chinese city. "Thank President Zelensky for

his phone call today. We exchanged views on the ongoing conflict, its humanitarian aspect, and efforts to restore peace and stability. India extends full support to all efforts in this direction," Modi said on

'X'. The Prime Minister landed in Tianjin this evening to attend the SCO summit.

President Zelensky also shared his perspective on the recent developments related to Ukraine.
