## HC asks govt to start demolishing illegal prawn gheries in wetlands

Cuttack: The decks have been cleared for the demolition of illegal prawn farms in Bhitar kanika National Park and the Chilika Lake with the Orissa high court directing the state government to start the process under the supervision of the committee formed for the

While issuing the direction on Monday, the high court has set March 18 as the date for taking stock of the work. It has also directed the government to lodge criminal proceedings against the offenders.

The Supreme Court had issued on April 3, 2017, asked the chief justice of high courts in 15 states to take up the issue of conservation of ecology of important wetlands. Of the 26 major wetlands located in the 15 states, two are in Odisha.

In pursuance of this, the high court had taken up the issue by *suo motu* registering a PIL in September 2017 for restoration of the ecology of the two wetlands - Bhitarkanika in Kendrapada district and the Chilika Lake, encompassing areas in Puri, Ganjam and Khurda districts.

Subsequently, it had appo inted Mohit Agarwal as amicus curiae to assist it. As part of the adjudication process, the amicus curiae filed a report raising six issues to be considered by the high court for preservation of the two wetlands — illegal prawn culture, pollution, uncontrolled boat operation and oil spills, siltation, depletion of mangrove forest in Bhitarkanika and prawn culture by illegal Bangladeshi migrants and po-

tion and eviction process of il legal prawn farms by using satellite imagery data and GPS'. Gheries are areas encroa-

ched for illegal prawn cultivation inside the wetland area According to the amicus curiae's report, 'in total, 23,000 acres are under illegal prawn culture' in Bhitarkanika and Chilika Lake.

In its order, the high court expected the chief secretary to provide manpower, machinery, police assistance and the committee to monitor the demolition and eviction of prawn farms.

The high court directed the collectors of the four districts to register criminal cases aga inst the evicted and expected details of the eviction and criminal cases in the progress report by the committee when the matter is taken up on March 18.

The committee constituted by the state government also includes the principal chief conservator of forests, chief executive officer of Chilika Development Authority and the collectors of Puri, Khurda, Ganjam and Kendrapada dis

# City's much-vaunted cycle tracks become parking lots

### **Riders Take** Roads, Risking Life & Limb

Bhubaneswar: To promote non-motorized transport in the city, the government had earmarked dedicated tracks along the major roads and painted them red for easy identification. The tracks were supposed to be free of the common problem of cars and motorcycles parked haphazardly. However, that dream has proved to be short-lived. In many places in the city, the tracks have turned into de facto bike and

car parking zones. The cycle tracks were developed in the run-up to the Men's Hockey World Cup the city hosted last year; the public bicycle-sharing (PBS) scheme was introduced on November 26. Because of obstructions on the tracks, the cycle riders have no choice but to step onto the busy streets. The random parking of vehicles has thus belied the entire purpose of the project.

"If you start from the dock after hiring the cycle, you will find not less than five to six obstructions where you will have to make a stop, bring the cycle onto the road and negotiate through cars and bikes for a few meters before you get a clear track for another few metres. This is killing our enthusiasm and speed. There should be continuity in the ride,"

cle on busy streets, where buses, cars and bikes are running at over 60 kmph. Secondly, motorcyclists are speeding on the cycle tracks and honking as if they are meant for them," complained Artatrana Das, another rider.

The arteries that have bicycle tracks earmarked are Governor House Square to KI-IT Square and Airport Square-Acharya Vihar-Kalinga Hospital. There are small sub-arteries where tracks have been demarcated. On the roads where the track is not constructed on a raised platform, a portion of the left side of the road has been demarcated for cycles with red paint.

The twin cities police commissioner Satyajit Mohanty and the Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC) commissioner Subham Saxena on Tuesday discussed on how to deal with abandoned vehicles on the road, which are also obstructing the cycle tracks.
