

# CM MAJHI REBUTS NAVEEN'S 'JUMLA' JIBE

CHIEF Minister Mohan Charan Majhi on Tuesday said his government has laid the foundation for transforming the state to 'Viksit Odisha' by 2036 when it will celebrate 100th year of its formation.

In his point-by-point rebuttal of the claims of Opposition Leader Naveen Patnaik who took a dig at the ruling BJP by terming it as 'name changer government' and all its promises in election manifesto as 'Jumla', the chief minister said only time will tell which government is a game changer.

Describing the first budget of

his government as welfare-centric, realistic and revolutionary, Majhi said, "It is a firm commitment of my government to cover all eligible women under Subhadra Yojana. The Women and Child Development department is preparing guidelines which will be completed within first 100 days of this government."

Asserting that funds will not be a constraint to implement the scheme, the CM said if necessary, additional budgetary provision will be made. Dispelling the apprehensions of the Leader of Opposition (LoP) about implementation of various promises made by BJP, he said it is quite natural for Naveen to suspect as his government failed

miserably to implement many schemes announced by him during his long tenure as chief minister.

Majhi said a number of schemes announced by the BJP government never saw light of the day as the intention of the regional party was to cheat the people to win election. Pointing out a few schemes, the CM sought to know about the status of the proposed world class new Barabati Stadium. "Was it not a Jumla?" he questioned.

The last ditch attempt by the Naveen Patnaik government to hijack the free rice supplied by Prime Minister Narendra Modi under Garib Kalyan Yojana by distributing a bag carrying BJD

symbol with 'Ama Odisha Nabin Odisha' logo before the general election was the biggest Jumla, Majhi said.

"The 5T programme under which schools were painted with green colour (the colour of BJD) turned out to be another Jumla as the school dropout rate is one of the highest in the country," he said.

Promising farmers a cash assistance of ₹10,000 per annum under KALLA Yojana before election and reducing the amount to ₹4,000 after winning the 2019 polls was another Jumla of the BJD government. "What happened to the much-tom-tommed PEETHA scheme and Jaga Mission," Majhi asked the LoP.

# In a first, 2nd vote-on-account of ₹95K crore taken in Odisha

CHIEF Minister Mohan Charan Majhi on Tuesday placed a vote-on-account of ₹95,000 crore to meet the expenditure for implementation of government schemes and other administrative requirements for two months.

The vote-on-account will be in force for August and September. This is the second vote-on-account taken by the state government during a financial year, which is a record for Odisha.

Official sources said the need for taking the second vote-on-account arose as the Appropriation Bill for the 2024-25 budget will be placed for approval in the Assembly on September 13. The chief minister had placed a budget of

₹2.65 lakh crore in the Assembly on July 25.

The then BJD government in the state had taken a vote-on-account of ₹1.18 lakh crore on February 8 for four months of the 2024-25 financial year in view of the Lok Sabha and Assembly elections. The first vote-on-account will last till July 31. Therefore, there was a need to take the approval of the House for making provision for functioning of the government for next two months, said the sources.

Major allocations for various schemes will be reflected in this exercise. Several flagship schemes to be launched by the state government including Subhadra Yojana and paddy purchase

from farmers at minimum support price of ₹3,100 per quintal, have received major chunk of the allocations.

The two vote-on-accounts taken by the government will exhaust ₹2,08,000 crore from the main budget to cover six months of 2024-25. Only ₹57,000 crore will be left for the next six months of the financial year. Official sources maintained that the state government may have

to go for a supplementary budget to cover all the schemes which have been announced. The expenditure of the government will increase as it has announced 19 schemes in the 2024-25 budget. Allocations for the schemes will be made accordingly.

# Oppn walkout over price rise

BHUBANESWAR: Accusing the state government of failing to bring down the prices of essential commodities, Opposition BJD staged a walkout from the Assembly on Tuesday.

The issue cropped up during discussion on adjournment motion with BJD members alleging that prices of essential commodities have skyrocketed within one-and-a-half months of the new government assuming office in the state. It is unfortunate on the part of government to say that it has no role to play in controlling the price rise, they said.

Trying to corner the state government over the price of potato which is selling at ₹40-₹50 at various markets, BJD member Niranjana Pujari alleged that there was no action plan to bring the price under control. Not only potato, onion is also selling at ₹50 per kg in the state.

Leader of the Congress Legislature Party Ramchandra Kadam came down heavily on the state government for remaining a mute spectator when prices of essential commodities are going up.

In his reply, Food Supplies and Consumer Welfare Minister Krushna Chandra Patra blamed the previous BJD government for the potato and onion crisis in the state. "The potato and onion missions of the erstwhile government have failed completely. Around ₹270 crore was wasted for these initiatives. Besides, the BJD government also failed to construct cold storages during the last 24 years," he said. ENS

# State lost 6.57L PMAY-G houses, govt blames BJD

ODISHA government on Tuesday said the state lost nearly 6.58 lakh housing units under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) in the last eight years and blamed the previous BJD regime for it.

Replying to a question from BJD MLA Manas Dutta, Panchayati Raj and Drinking Water Min-

ister Rabi Narayan Naik informed the Assembly that the previous government failed to submit the list of beneficiaries to the Centre in time from 2016 to 2024. As a result, the state lost central assistance for 6,57,945 PMAY-G houses during this period.

The minister said the central government has so far sanctioned over 42.18 lakh houses to the state out of which more than 36.57 lakh units have been constructed. Over

5.27 lakh housing units are under construction. Work on 32,913 sanctioned houses is yet to start and 1,26,719 applications are pending for approval.

After the outbreak of Covid-19, the then government could not prepare a final list of PMAY beneficiaries till the end of 2022-23 financial year leading to protest from the BJP over alleged irregularities in beneficiary selection. Responding to a separate query

from BJD MLA Dhruva Charan Sahu, Naik who is also the Minister for Rural Development, said 8,300 villages of the state have no all-weather connectivity. Of the 59,971 villages in the state, all-weather connectivity has been provided to 51,671 villages under PMGSY. Road connectivity programme taken up for 1,226 villages under the state programme of the previous government has been completed.
