

Odisha set to be innovation-driven economy by 2036, says chief secy

Chief secretary Anu Garg on Friday asserted that Odisha will transform into a high-income, inclusive, climate-resilient and innovation-driven economy by 2036, coinciding with the centenary of its statehood and aligning with India's 100 years of independence in 2047.

Speaking at the inaugural session of the two-day conclave 'Vikash Manthan 1.0 - Governance in Action', she highlighted that Odisha's GDP at current prices is estimated at ₹9.9 lakh crore in 2025-26, reflecting a 9.5 per cent increase over the previous year. "The real growth rate of 7.9 per cent of the state surpasses the national average. The state's per capita income has nearly tripled over the past decade, rising from

₹64,835 in 2015-16 to ₹1,86,761 in 2025-26," she said. The chief secretary outlined strong sectoral momentum across agriculture, industry and services. Agriculture and allied sectors continue to outperform national averages in both contribution and growth rate. The industrial sector, contributing over 41 per cent to GSDVA, is driven by

robust manufacturing expansion, while the services sector is projected to grow at 9.3 per cent, she added.

Additional chief secretary of Industries Hemant Sharma said the industrial sector is poised for further expansion with a calibrated shift from a predominantly mining-led economy towards metallurgy and allied value-addition sectors.

Pointing to Odisha's cost advantage, he stressed the need to build a robust petrochemical and coastal chemicals ecosystem, while also identifying food processing and textiles as high-potential sunrise areas. "Emerging domains such as green energy equipment and semiconductor industries have already gained initial traction in the state and can significantly enrich Odisha's industrial horizon in the coming years," he said.

Additional chief secretary of Electronics and IT Vishal Dev underscored Odisha's strong macro-fiscal position, stating the state's revenue surplus and prudent debt-GSDP ratio, which provides strategic headroom for future investments. "Around 350 IT companies are currently operating in Odisha. With upgraded IT and semiconductor policies and India's first dedicated AI Policy, the state aims to build over 100 global capability centres (GCCs) and transition from a mine-driven economy to a mind-driven economy," Dev added.

Development commissioner DK Singh, editor of *The Organizer* Prafulla Kerkar and organising secretary of OCID Rana Prithviraj Singh also spoke.

Navy to induct 15 warships in 2026, create benchmark

INDIAN Navy plans to induct about 15 warships in 2026, setting an unprecedented benchmark of fleet expansion in the service's history, according to Chief of Naval Staff Admiral Dinesh K Tripathi.

Speaking in Chennai after commissioning INS Anjadip, a new shallow-water anti-submarine warfare (ASW) platform, on Friday, Chief of Naval Staff Dinesh K Tripathi said the Navy had commissioned 12 warships and one submarine in 2025 alone, signalling a sustained acceleration in force induction.

The Navy is on course to become a 200-plus ship force by 2035, Tripathi said, adding that all 50 vessels currently on order are being built in Indian shipyards.

"Moving beyond platforms, our aim is to take atmanirbharta to the component level and build a fully self-reliant force by 2047," the admiral said, while stressing that indigenous capability would need to be matched with partnerships and interoperability to remain effective in a contested maritime environment.

He said the Navy is placing renewed emphasis on undersea and anti-submarine warfare - a capability gap that has drawn growing scrutiny as strategic competition intensifies across the Indo-Pacific.

Anjadip is the fourth of 16 shallow-water ASW craft planned for induction and is intended primarily for operations along India's eastern seaboard. Equipped with shallow-water sonars, lightweight torpedoes, anti-submarine rockets and an

indigenous combat management system, the vessel is designed for coastal and littoral operations, where submarine detection is particularly challenging.

Admiral Tripathi said the class reflects a broader shift towards improving maritime domain awareness and sea-denial capabilities close to shore, even as larger surface combatants and submarines expand India's blue-water reach.

The accelerated build-up comes against what Tripathi described as a "complex and sensitive" maritime security environment, marked by the spillover of continental tensions into sea lanes that underpin global trade and energy flows.

He said since October 2023, Indian naval deployments in the Red Sea have escorted nearly 400 merchant vessels carrying oil and cargo worth more than \$7bn and from India, according to official estimates. Indian warships continue to operate alongside partner navies in anti-piracy patrols and coordinated surveillance missions across the Indian Ocean Region.

Anjadip's induction also highlights the Navy's evolving industrial ecosystem. The vessel was built through a public-private collaboration led by Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers in partnership with L&T Kattappadi, while its combat management system was designed by Bharat Electronics Limited.

The ship's name carries historical resonance, recalling Anjadip island off Goa, which witnessed decisive naval action during the 1961 operation that led to the territory's liberation.

AS the Jammu and Kashmir cricket team is inching closer towards winning its first-ever Ranji Trophy final being played in Hubballi, Jammu and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah landed in the city on Friday to cheer for his team.

He will be at the Raj Nagar cricket stadium on Saturday to witness the historic event. Hours before landing in the city, he posted on X, "On our way to Hubballi to cheer for the J&K cricket team as they play the final of the Ranji Trophy. They've already made lakhs of people so very proud of their achievements by reaching the final. I'm really looking forward to spending the day tomorrow in the stands cheering them on."

Upon arriving, he said it is a matter of pride that the team reached the Ranji final for the first time. "We will return from here with the trophy," he said. "It was projected that it would be difficult for us to win in the final. But we have played well. With the team entering the final, people now realise that there are talented cricketers in Jammu and Kashmir as well. Because of lack of opportunities, our players have not been able to gain recognition at the national level. After this final, I am confident that one or two of our players will go on to represent India."

In the Ranji Trophy final being played at the Raj Nagar stadium in Jammu, and Kashmir tightened their grip on Karnataka, putting the hosts under severe pressure.

HC lifts stay, clears release of 'The Kerala Story 2'

KOCHI: The Kerala High Court on Friday granted permission for the release of 'The Kerala Story 2 - Goes Beyond', a sequel to the controversial film 'The Kerala Story'. The court, in a single judge's order, lifted the stay on the film's screening for 15 days. The order will pave the way for the release of the film in more than 1,800 theatres across the country and on 355 screens abroad.

A division bench comprising Justice Sudhrit Arvind Dharmadhikari and Justice P V Balakrishnan issued the order on an appeal filed by Vipul Am-

ruthal Shah, proprietor of Sunshine Pictures, Mumbai, seeking to quash the single judge's order. The division bench, which had reserved its order after an urgent hearing that lasted around two hours on Thursday night, passed the interim order at 4pm on Friday.

Earlier on Thursday, the single judge had stayed the release of the movie - originally scheduled for Friday - after verifying the contents of the teaser and finding that it had a "prima facie

potential to distort public perception and disturb communal harmony". The judge had observed that the film had reserved its order after an urgent hearing that lasted around two hours on Thursday night, passed the interim order at 4pm on Friday.

The division bench, in its order, stated that once a certificate has been issued, there is, prima facie, a presumption that the authority concerned has taken into account all the guidelines, including public order. ENS
