'No casteism please' posters greet Rahul Gandhi in Rae Bareilly

Harshit Singh objected to a statement made by Rahul Gandhi during his last meeting where he raised questions about the caste of administrative officials.

SP leader's statement on terror attack is shameful, reflects Pakistan's narrative: CM Yogi

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday condemned recent remarks by Samajwadi Party (SP) leaders on the Pahalgam terrorist attack, calling them "shameful" and akin to Pakistani rhetoric.

He criticised SP leaders for dismissing the killing of Shubham Dwivedi and for divisive statements like labelling it a "Hindu killing Hindu" incident. The CM also accused the SP and Congress of using caste-based politics and appeasement, warning that such tactics jeopardise national security.

Addressing a public meeting in Deoria during the inauguration of 341 out of 501 development projects worth Rs676 crore and laying of foundation stone for 160 others, CM Yogi Adityanath reflected on the region's grim state before 2017, marked by lawlessness, disease, and neglect. He highlighted how peaceful festival celebrations were impossible, youth had to migrate for work, and farmers faced extreme distress. Marginalised communities like Musahar and Vantangiya endured starvation, while those in power remained indifferent and isolated.

On the occasion, he also distributed benefits under various government schemes. These included loan cheques under the Mukhyamantri Yuva Udyami Yojana, Rs 7.87 crore to members of self-help groups, keys to homes under the CM Rural Housing Scheme, tractors, and land lease papers to 37 beneficiaries under the Patta Yojana. He also handed out cheques for Divyang and destitute pensions. Academic achievers

Congress leader of the opposition in the Lok Sabha and Rae Bareilly MP Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday on a two days visit of his constituency visited several places and chaired a meeting of development in his area.

He first inaugurated two MW Atom Solar Roof Plant and Atom Electric Charging Station at Visakha Factory in Kundanganj and later joined the District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee (Disha) meeting as Chairman.

While on his way from Visakha to Collectorate, Rahul Gandhi stopped his car in the midway to talk to the local people and shook hands with some youths and children.

He later unveiled the statue of Subhash Chandra Bose on the civil line of the city and



distributed 15 hand carts to the needy people.

In the Disha meeting, Congress MP enquired about the development works and was even annoyed with delay in some projects. The meeting continued for 2 hours where officials of 78 departments are present. UP minister Dinesh Pratap Singh and Amethi MP Kishori Lal Sharma were also present in the meeting.

The last Disha's meeting was held on 5 November 2024. In the afternoon at 1530 hrs, Rahul Gandhi reached Rail Coach Factory (RCF) in Lalganj. He dis-

cussed the progress of the railway coach production with the railway coach officials. He also inspected the Rail Coach Factory along with PK Mishra, General Manager of Railcoach factory and other officials.

Before retiring for the night, Rae Bareilly MP will hold assembly level meetings with the booth presidents of Sareni at Muraibagh Dalmau.

He will have a night stay in Bhumu Mau guest house and tomorrow he will go to Amethi and then to Kanpur before leaving for Delhi in the evening.

Mayawati seeks full support for her nephew Akash
