

Ambulance to Rehabilitation centre for Divyang at Cuttack

MCL has provided financial assistance of Rs. 16,33,686/- to Swami Vivekanand National Institute of Rehabilitation, Training & Research (SVNIRTR), Cuttack for procurement of Ambulance. The Institute is an autonomous body under the administrative control of the Department of Empowerment of Divyangjan, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt of India.

The Institute imparts professional courses and training at various UG & PG level, undertakes research activity, conducts vocation training on rehabilitation, and is also engaged in manufacturing assistive devices.

The Centre is connected with MCL by providing rehabilitation services in the peripheral villages of Talcher and Ib coalfields. It runs a 100 bedded hospital at Cuttack and offers services to polio patients with limb deformity and reconstructive surgeries for cured leprosy patients. The Institute has been declared as a Centre of excellence by the Govt in 2015.

The Ambulance will serve the needs of patients for emergency referral to Cuttack/Bhubaneswar for specialised treatment. Apart from this, the Ambulance will also serve the rural locations.
