(Provisional Figures)



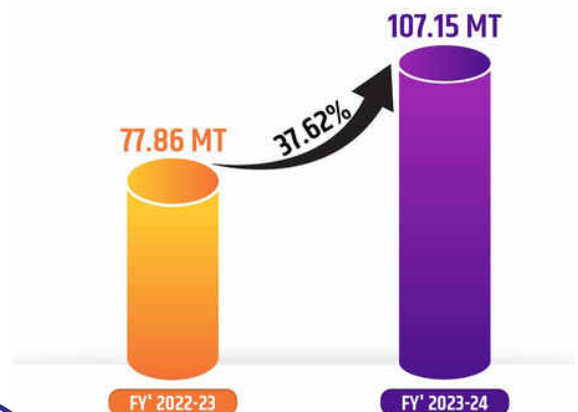

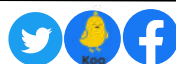
