MCL to set-up super critical thermal power plant in Sundargarh

The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) on has approved the proposal for equity investment by Mahanadi Coalfields Limited (MCL) for setting up 2×800 Mw thermal power plant in Odisha's Sundargarh district of Odisha.

The CCEA chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved equity investment for 2×800 MW Supercritical Thermal Power Plant in Sundergarh district through 'Mahanadi Basin Power Ltd' (MBPL), a wholly owned subsidiary of MCL.
